

# AMERICAN ROSE SOCIETY 2008 GUIDE TO U.S. GARDENS

This “2008 Garden Guide,” the third edition of this annual feature, contains all gardens that subscribe to the **Reciprocal Admissions Program (RAP)** – indicated with an asterisk \* — and brief entries for many significant rose gardens, plus a limited number of nursery gardens that are open to the public. RAP gardens are listed because, in most cases, all you need do is show your ARS membership card to gain free or reduced-cost admission. **“Free w/ARS card”** is your ticket to enjoying these gardens! However, family members will *as a general rule* need to pay unless they have joined ARS as Associate Members (\$13) or as a Youth Member (\$10) and, therefore, have their own membership card. When you are planning excursions, phone ahead to confirm card benefits — especially for estate gardens, privileges may be limited.

Since last year there has been a slight uptick in the number of reciprocating gardens where ARS membership confers a decided benefit, about 5 percent, from 200 to 209. We have also been able to identify a number of gardens where there is no charge at all, and this has been indicated in the updated “Guide.” As a general rule, in particular with nursery gardens, you should phone in advance to make sure the gardens are open at the time you are planning to visit.

Sadly we must note the passing of Colonel Mel Hulse (USAF, ret.), the long-time guiding light of the San Jose Heritage Rose Garden. Mel was widely and justifiably admired for his love and great knowledge of roses, his serious and enthusiastic commitment to the Heritage Rose Garden and old garden roses, in general, and his leadership of all the best causes in today’s rose culture.

For many of us, 2008 is the year of the sustainable rose garden. The establishment of the new Good Earth Rose Committee ([www.organicrosecare.org](http://www.organicrosecare.org)) and the appearance of a regular feature column on environmental gardening in *American Rose* indicate just how serious ARS is about life quality issues. The Great Rosarians of the World VIII honored William Radler, the hybridizer of ‘Knock Out’, the “poster rose” of sustainability in the garden, and also sponsored, on April 5th at The New York Botanical Garden, the first-ever symposium on the no-spray sustainable garden with Steve Jones and Marilyn Wellan, current and immediate past ARS presidents, participating as part of a distinguished panel discussion!

With membership card and this “Guide” in hand, however, we plan to visit beautiful rose gardens this summer and fall — and trust you will do so, too.
